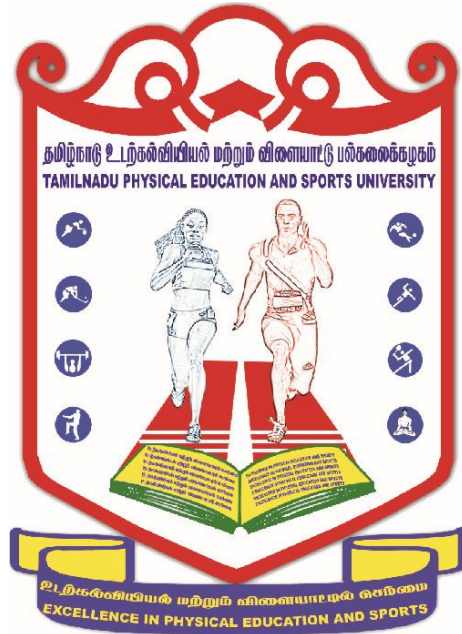



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ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

The Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University established by an Act of the Government of Tamil Nadu in 2004, is unique and the first of its kind in India as an affiliatory University, exclusively for Physical Education and Sports. After obtaining the accent from his Excellency the president of India on 5th August 2005, the said act came into force with effect from 15th September 2005.

It is a rare coincidence that the University has started functioning from December 2005, declared by the United Nations as International year for Sport and Physical Education. At present the University has three Faculties, five Departments and ten affiliated Colleges. Further the University now offers select Physical Education and Allied Courses, through collaborative program and Distance Education stream also.

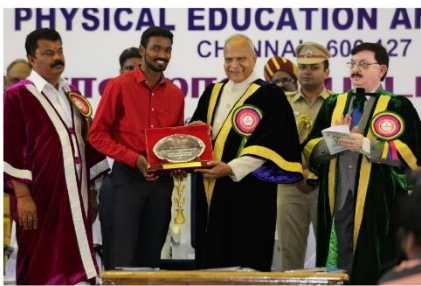

LIBRARY

TNPESU University Library established during the year 2007 and up to 2017 the Library was functioned in the temporary space provided in the administrative and academic blocks. During the year 2018 the University Library housed in a two storied new Building with total carpet area of 6772 Sq. Ft (629.11sq.mts.). Located at the western side in the University campus. This area is divided into following sections: Circulation, Technical Processing, Reading Hall, e-Library, Periodical, Stack and Thesis section. The University Central Library occupies an indispensable Place in the Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University, which enhances Teaching, Research & Development activities. It is a most lively placed department in the campus providing resources in a user friendly environment to enable learning and advancement of knowledge and whereby discovering new insights in all the academic programmes offered in this University.

1. Procurement

1.1 Procurements of Books, Journals & Budget

a. Books

In the year 2018-2019 Rs. 25 Lakhs was allotted for Procurement of Books and additionally Rs. 10 Lakhs was allotted. Book Procurement was done in three phase on April 2018, November 2018 and February 2019.

b. Journals

A Sum amount Rs 5 Lakhs earmarked for the subscription of print Journals. To utilize this amount initiation has been took during the month of November 2018 to receive the UGC Recommended print Journals from various heads of Department a circular was sent and they have submitted their recommended print Journals list for



their respective Departments. A total of 64 print Journals have been recommended by 5 Head of Departments in which we have found 5 Duplicate Titles and the same was removed. The Final 59 print Journal list has been submitted to the Registrar for Subscription. The Subscription Process going on. The list of prominent subscription agencies functioning in India are also submitted along with the consolidated list on 19.12.18.

c. Budget

This University Library has requested the University Authorities to sanction a sum amount Rs. 92,37,840 as Budget estimate for the year 2018-2019. This University Authorities after careful investigations has sanctioned a sum amount Rs 39,52,000. We have received a confirmation letter from Finance Officer on 11.04.2018 in which this University has requested the University Library to utilize the sanctioned amount. The Assistant Librarian has taken the initiation to utilize the amount for various heads. A Major Amount has been sanctioned for the Purchase of books. Hence necessary steps have been taken during the month of April 2018 for conduct of book exhibition in the month of April 2018, November 2018, Feb 2019 Based on this initiation 545 Books were Purchased in the first Phase 419 Books will be ordered soon.

A Sum amount Rs 5 Lakhs earmarked for the subscription of print Journal. To utilize this amount initiation has been taken during the month of Nov 2018 to receive the UGC Recommended print Journals from various the heads of Department have submitted their recommended print Journals list for their respective Department. A total of 64 print Journals have been recommended by 5 Head of Departments in which we have found 5 Duplicate Titles and the same was removed. The Final 59 print Journal list has been submitted to the registrar for Subscription. The Subscription Process going on. The list of prominent subscription agencies functioning in India are also submitted along with the consolidated list on 19.12.18.

Rs.8 Lakhs worth of electronic Gadgets has been allotted to modernize the University Library. The specifications for the electronic items have been submitted for purchase during the month of April 2018 and this University Library has received only 3 Printers so far. The rest of the equipments have to be ordered.



A Sum amount Rs 10 Lakhs has been additionally allotted for procurement of books on 04.12.2018. Necessary steps have been carried out to utilize the additional allotment a book display in the book suppliers premises initiated during the month of February 2019 for selection of books by various Department Faculties a total of 1200 titles have been selected during this book selection.

1.2 Book Processing

During the Academic year November 2018 to January 2019, 545 books were purchased in first phase and it was technically processed on 10th January to 15th February 2019. We have entered 545 books in University Library Accession Register, Database and Barcode numbers generated and the same was pasted in the spine of the Books and shelved in the Stack section.

1.3 Thesis Addition

During this academic year COE section supplied 1092 Project & theses reports to University Library. We have added 1092 reports/Theses in University Library Theses database and barcode numbers generated and the same was pasted in the spine, the reports divided into PG report & Ph.D thesis and shelved in the theses section.

2. Maintenance of Books, Journals & Reports 2.1 Shelf

Order Maintenance

This University Authorities instructed the University Assistant Librarian to shift the Library from Academic Building to newly constructed building. Based on this shifting of Library Resources, Furnitures, Equipments etc, work was carried out from 6th August 2018 to 24th August 2018.

Shelf rectification work was did from 18th Feb 2019 to 22nd Feb 2019.

New books purchased for University Library Shelved in the stack section according to the DDC Scheme of classification during 04th March 2019 to 22nd March 2019.

DDC Scheme of classification was adopted to classify the subject wise Books. Hence the row wise Books arranged in the racks according to DDC Scheme was prepared and



displayed in front of each row of racks in the stack section. This will facilitate the users to locate the books quickly. This work was done during 25th March 2019 to 29th March 2019.

In thesis Section, the reports & thesis was arranged according to the Accession Numbers. This work was done during the month of September 2018.

2.2 Damaged/ Torned/Mutilated books

In stack section few books found to be in a torned conditions these books were identified and maintained with pasting work. 26 such torned books have been identified and treated for pasting work. The pasted and maintained books reshelved in the stack on 3rd April, 2019 to 5th April 2019.

2.3 Long Due Book Reminder

173 books borrowed by staff & Students listed and University Library remained them to return the books. Based on this initiation all the books have been returned by the Students.

2.4 Newspaper Received

During the working days this University Library receives daily newspapers from a vendor. The supplied daily's entered in a separate register on day to day basis. After completion of a particular month the supplier will submit a bill for payment. During this academic year eight such bills received and passed for payment.

3. Delivery of services

3.1 Membership

238 students and seven Guest Lecturers (i.e. 245 members) have been enrolled as members in University Library during the Year 2018. We have prepared barcode membership ID card laminated in University Library and issued to 238 Students and Five Guest Lecturers.

Duplicate Membership Card Issued to Students

Few students have lost their membership ID Cards which was fine members sought to the knowledge of this University Library. 15 students have requested duplicate ID cards and



they have paid the fine a sum amount Rs.750/-(15x50=750) has been collected as fine and they have paid the said amount in University. Account at Indian Bank through challan.

For final year students the membership ID cards should be surrender to University Library. Few students and Staffs have lost their ID cards. As per the University Library rules they have to pay Rs.50 as fine towards the lost of membership ID card. 24 students and 2 staffs a total of 26 members have lost their card and paid a sum amount Rs.1300(26X50=1300) in the University Account through Indian Bank challan. The challan proof copy has submitted to the Finance section.

3.2 Books Issued & Returned to Students & Staff

In Circulation section books circulated to all members and works such as Issue and Return are carried out. In 2018-2019 Academic year a total of 932 books have been issued to Students, M.Phil/Ph.D Scholars and Staff. In turn 899 books have been returned by the students and staffs to University Library.

3.3 Reprographic Services

Reprographic service is provided in University Library. A total of 12080 copies generated and issued to students and staffs. A sum amount Rs.12795/- collected from members and Non-members. The sum amount collected as reprographic charges has been deposited in University account and every month statement, Bank Challan submitted to the concerned officer. So for ten such statements submitted. 7667 copies have been reproduced for official purpose. A total of 12080 copies generated and issued to students and staffs. Therefore 19747 copies have been generated in Reprographic section during this academic year.

3.4 Books & Theses Referred

A. Books Referred by Students

Students Visiting University Library referred Books for their Study, Research purpose. A total of 573 Books have been referred during this academic year.



B. Theses Referred by students

A total of 99 times Theses referred by M.Phil/Ph.D Scholars and PG Students in the theses section.

3.5 Visitors List Member & Non Member

The University Library everyday walk-in is calculated. The visitors list is generated using Gate Entry Management System (GEMS) and Gate Entry Register. A total of 9278 no. of Visitors entered into the University Library during the academic year 2018-2019 and utilized resources and services of Library.

3.6 No-Dues Faculties & Students

A Total of 483 members (473 Students+6 Staffs) have been issued no due certificate by this University Library during the year 2018-2019.

4. Assistance to University Department

4.1 Journal Publications(JPESAD)

The editorial board received eight articles for publication in JPESAD. This University Library received the article and sent for experts review, experts submitted their comments for corrections. The same was intimated to the contributor. The contributors corrected their articles and the final copy submitted to the experts for inclusion in JPESAD. So far 7 articles have been reviewed, corrected and included for publication.

e Vice-Chancellor instructed to upgrade the journal as UGC approved Journal. Initial steps have been took for UGC approval. A request letter has been submitted for designing web page for University Journal & Indexing the Journal with a Publisher. For indexing a mail was sent to EBSCO Publisher. They have sent a form, the form was submitted to the publisher. The Publisher finally informed that the team will scrutinize the form and it will take six months time for including JPESAD as Indexed Journal in their Database.

4.2 Newspaper Clippings

Daily Newspaper clippings pertaining to academic institute will be photocopied and sent to the University Authorities. A total of 35 such clippings have been sent to the authorities.



4.3 Staff Recruitment

One Technical Assistant Library discontinued his job in September 2018. A request letter has been submitted by this University Library to recruit Technical Assistant as replacement for that Post. On 27.12.2018 interview was conducted 3 persons attended the interview. And a person got selected his name is Mr. SaravanaKumaran Appointment order was send to him on 07.01.2019. He reported to his job on 09.01.2019.

4.4 Shifting Work

The new Library Building was inaugurated by Chief Minister of Tamilnadu on 16.07.2018. Books and Furnitures available in Library was shifted on 19th July 2018 to 21st July 2018. Under NSS Coordinator guidance NSS Student Volunteers helped in shifting Library materials to the new Library Building. A sum amount Rs. 3500 received as advance amount for shifting work in which Rs.3429 has been spent and the balance amount Rs.71 remitted into the University account.

4.5 Academic Audit

This University has informed the University Library Through a circular dated 05.03.2018 that an academic audit has been scheduled from 27th to 29th March 2019. Based on this communication we have prepared the Library to meet the Academic Audit Initiations have been took to get back the pending books from the students and staffs. Minute Arrangement of Books, Thesis and old Newspapers have been carried out on 25.03.2019. Torned and Mutilated books have been identified from the stock and it was cello taped and pasted & replaced into the stack. A report has been prepared to face the Academic Audit.

The Academic Audit team comprising of Dr .K. Vaithyanathan & Dr . Sivaramkrishnan visit the Library on 28.03.2019 Afternoon around 2.30 PM. The Assistant Librarian briefed the Academic Audit team about the recent and past activities of University Library. He also briefed the important achievements of University Library to the visiting team. The team personally went to each and every sections of University Library and finally the team members requested the Library report prepared by the Assistant Librarian. The team felt happy about the functioning of the University Library.

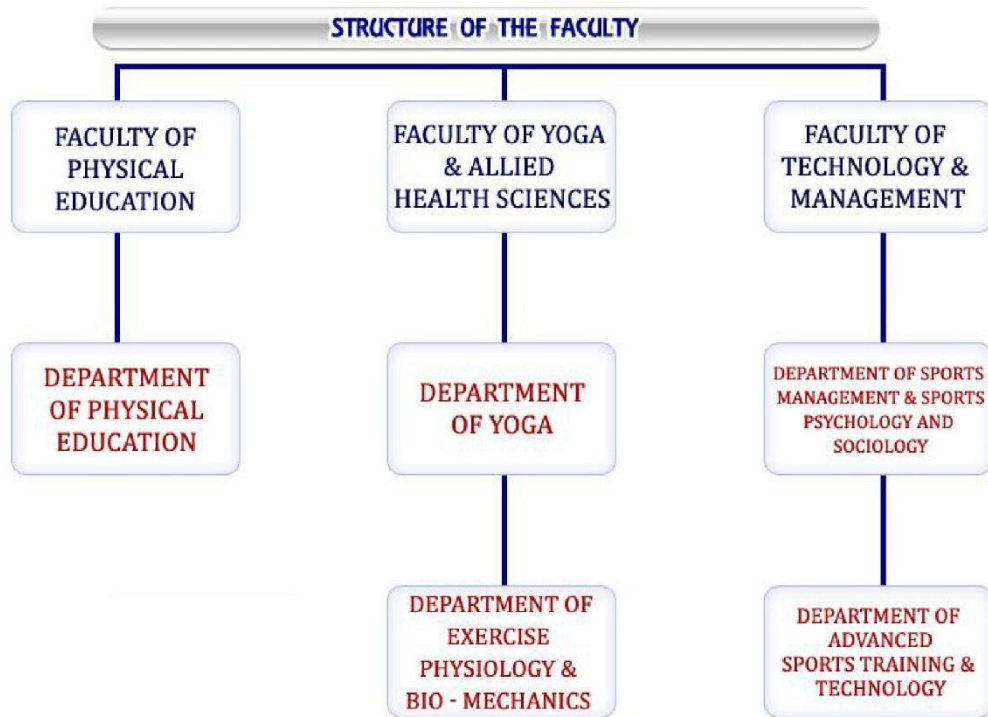

The TNPESU NSS Unit in association with Tagore Medical College organized blood donation and medical checkup for the students and staffs of TNPESU on 05.07.2018.





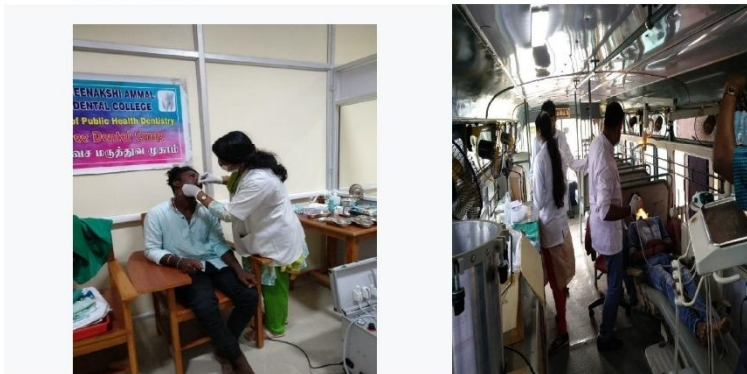
3. Tree Plantation

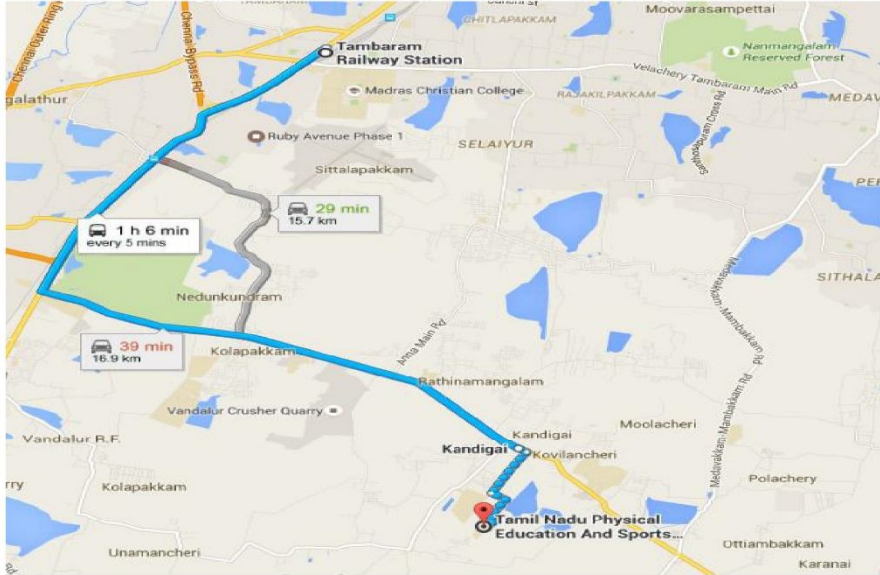

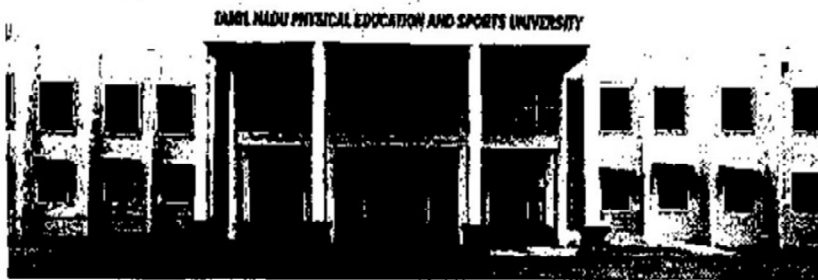

ANNUAL REPORT

It is a great privilege for me to present the report of this University for the academic year 2018-2019. Presently there are 24 affiliated colleges offering courses in Physical Education, and Sports, out of which 4 are Yoga Colleges. About 627 students have been enrolled in various programs of our University departments at this campus and 3686 in various affiliated colleges.

I am glad to inform that the Government of Tamil Nadu has announced the following schemes & grants towards the development of infrastructural facilities and academic excellence.

- Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, in the Budget session has announced Rs. 3.50 crores towards the construction of Staff quarters and Hon'ble Minister of Youth Welfare and Sports has generously announced a sum of Rs.14.52 Lakhs towards setting up of digital Language laboratory.

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- A sum of Rs.20 Crores has been sanctioned through the RUSA Scheme for overall development of our University
- We are in the process of establishing the Centres of Excellence in Table Tennis and Badminton with the sanction of Rs.12.60 crores and Rs.13.33 crores respectively. A sum of Rs.14.59 crores is sanctioned for the establishment of students' Hostel with a capacity of 400 students. Our Heartfelt thanks to the Chief Minister, Sports Minister and Principal Secretary, Government of Tamil Nadu for such financial support which in turn nurtures academic excellence.

I am indebted to place before this august gathering that we are successful in reaching our goals by establishing modernised e-Library, Pedagogy laboratory, Multi Gym and ATM centre in our campus.

We are at the verge of completion of the Centre of Excellence in Sports Biomechanics sanctioned by TANU with the cost of Rs.13.13 crores and a construction of Sports hostel at the cost of Rs.4.24 crores. The establishment of the Synthetic track, Kataripayattu and Silambam Training Centre are in the pipeline.

- Academic Audit was conducted on 27th to 29th March 2019
- Value Added Certificate Courses (12 numbers) are introduced from the academic year 2019-20.
- Peer Group Teaching Concept (PGTC) was introduced to enrich the teaching and discussion abilities among the students during the academic year 2018-19.
- To commensurate smooth functioning of this Institution and for Quality enhancement and Sustenance, several new committees have been formed and have modified some of the existing committees such as IQAC, Internal Complaint Committee, Grievance Redressal Committee, Task Force committee, University Development Council, CIQA (Distance Education) Anti Ragging Committee Research proposal Committee, ICT cell, NAAC Committee at this University.
- The Research Alliance is in full swing to attract the research aspirants and attends to the needs of the Research Scholars.
- The library has been well equipped with adequate resource materials and provides adequate internet services to support the Research work of the students.
- Staff and students of all the Departments are provided with laboratory facilities and guidance for conducting the, research and consultancy in our University.
- We have brought out our university Journal successfully titled "Journal of Physical Education Sports and Allied Disciplines" and have released about Nine volumes till date.
- Our students and faculty members have taken part in many conferences as Resources persons and also have published 117 research articles in both International and National level journals and scientific proceedings.
- Through Village Placement Programme our students served more than 20 villages to create awareness for Physical Fitness, Sports, Recreation, Yoga and Health.



- Sports Authority of India's Six Weeks Certificate Course in summer and winter sessions were conducted in this University.
- Special examinations were conducted for the sports participants who could not attend regular semester examinations.
- To commemorate the World Mental Health Day, the Department of Sports Management and Sports Psychology and Sociology in association with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organized an awareness program on 10th October 2019, on the theme "Mental Health Promotion and Suicide Prevention". This included education and creating a consciousness among the rural general population of Kandigai and Melakottaiyur. A poster competition was also held for the students of TNPESU on the related mental health themes.

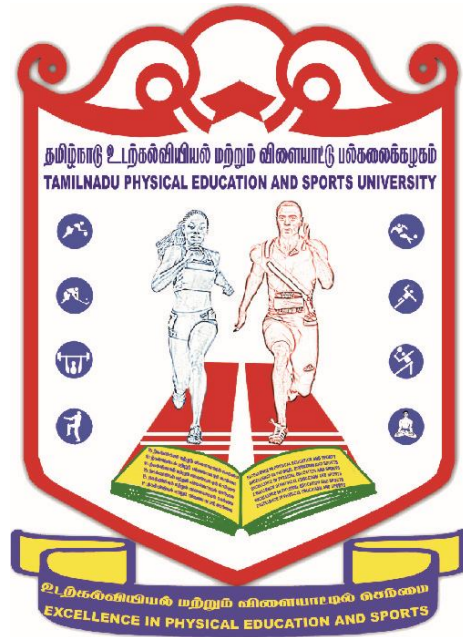
Finally, I appeal to the graduates to dedicate their service for the progress of this great nation so that we can march ahead as a world leader in Sports and Physical Education.

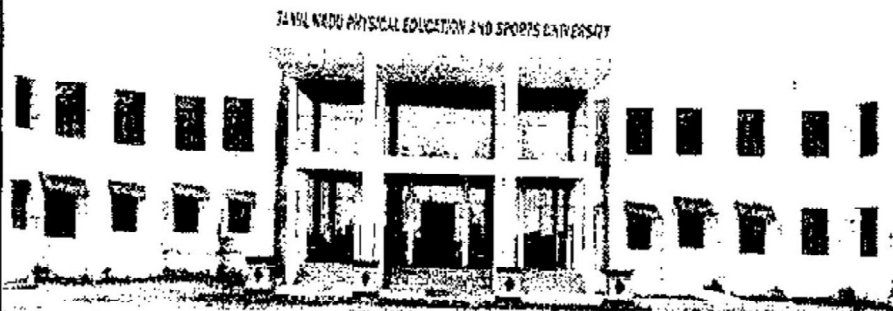

Affiliated Colleges

At present there are Twenty Four Colleges affiliated to this University, out of which 4 Colleges are exclusively for Yoga

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and the rest of the Colleges are offering various courses in Physical Education and Sports. Overall enrollment of students of all affiliated colleges of Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University is 1727 including the students of University departments. Mass College of Physical Education, Vanur Taluk, Villupuram District has been granted fresh affiliation for offering B.P.Ed., Course from the Academic Year 2018-19 with an annual intake of 50 students initially.

School of Distance Education

In order to cater to the needs of people who could not pursue higher education in the formal/on-campus streams, this University has taken an ambitious decision to enter the field of distance education by offering professional and job oriented academic programmes.

The School of Distance Education of this University is presently offering a record number of 18 Post graduate Degree Programmes, 11 Under graduate Degree Programmes, 19 PG Diploma Programmes, 19 Diploma Programmes and 14 Certificate programmes through Distance Mode. 4059 Students were admitted in the academic year 2017-18 for various courses which are being offered through distance mode.

I also take this opportunity to make a special note on the developments and achievements of the University during the period 2017-18. We extend our heartfelt thanks to the Government for having granted funds to add more infrastructural facilities which in turn can nurture academic excellence.

- A sum of Rs.15 crores has been announced by the Government during the Budget demand, 2018-19 of Youth Welfare and Sports Development Department towards construction of hostel at the University and a sum of Rs.10 Crores towards establishing a Table Tennis Academy at Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University.
- A sum for Rs. 10 Crores towards establishing Badminton Academy at Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University.
- A sum of Rs.4.675 crores has been sanctioned by the Government of Tamil Nadu towards construction of additional class rooms over the first floor of the academic block and the work is in progress.
- A sum of Rs.1.76 crores has been sanctioned for upgrading the Men's Hostel and Rs.1.045 crores for the second floor in women's hostel.
- A sum of Rs. 2.51 crores has been sanctioned by the Government of Tamil Nadu towards establishment of e-library.
- A sum of Rs.13.12 crores has been sanctioned towards Establishment of Centre of Excellence in Sports Biomechanics under TANU Scheme (vide G.O. Ms. No-35, Youth Welfare and Sports Development (YW2) Department, dated-31.07.2017).
- A sum of Rs. 4.74 crores has been sanctioned towards Construction of Sports Hostel vide G.O. Ms. No - 50, YWSD, Dt-15.11.2017.



- A sum of Rs.7.00 crores was allotted to lay down the synthetic track with 8 lanes from which Rs. 3.50 crores has been released by the Government under Khelo India Scheme and the work is in progress.
- A sum of Rs. 1.6 crores has been sanctioned towards Establishment of Traditional Kalaripayattu and Silambam Training Centre under TANII scheme (vide G.O. Ms. No - 20, Youth Welfare and Sports Development (YW2) Department dated - 18.07.2018).
- A sum of Rs. 22.05 lakhs has been sanctioned towards Establishment of Pedagogy Laboratory for Teaching, Testing and Training in Physical Education under TANII Scheme (vide G.O. Ms. No - 20, Youth Welfare and Sports Development (YWSD) Department, dated - 18.07.2018).

Further Proposals were submitted to the Central Government under Khelo India Scheme for the following:

- Proposed to setting up of infrastructure on the University campus regarding the Construction of Swimming Pool (including all weather swimming pool) to the tune of Rs. 8.00 crores.
- Proposed to setting up of infrastructure on the University campus regarding Astroturf Hockey Field with lighting Facilities to the tune of Rs.6.00 crores.

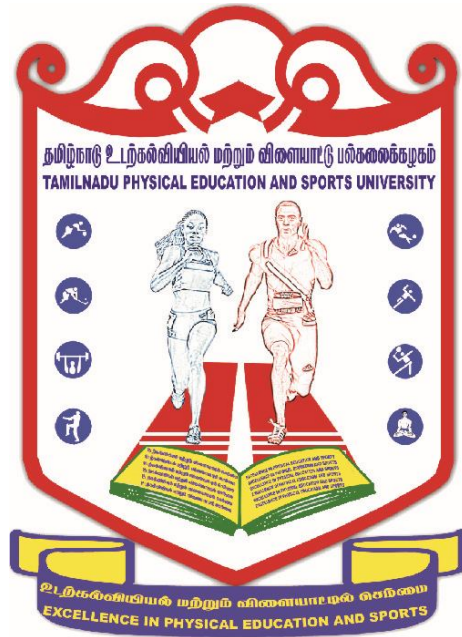

I am proud to inform you all that the Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University has been accredited with **B++ Grade** by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) recently on 05-11-2016 during my tenure as Vice-Chancellor with the efforts and cooperation of our teaching, non-teaching and students of this University. An Expert committee from UGC has also visited the Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University for grant of 12-B Status to the University and the same is awaited. Approval has been obtained from the National Council for Technical Education for conduct of B.P.Ed. Course with an intake of 100 students and admission has been started from the Academic Year 2016-17 onwards.

I am very much thankful to the Government for granting funds for the development of infrastructural facilities in the University Campus such as "for the construction of Additional Class rooms at a cost of Rs. 4.675 crores", "for the construction of Second Floor over the Gents Hostel at a cost of Rs. 1.76 crores", "for the construction of Second Floor over the Girls Hostel at a cost of Rs. 1.045 crores", Establishment of e-Library at a cost of Rs. 2.51 Crores" and "release of second instalment of one-time catch-up grant of Rs.2.49 crores" during the year 2016-17.

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During the year 2016-17, the following Infrastructural developments were carried out and completed in the University Campus.

- (1) Formation of Road in and around the University Campus
- (2) Multi-purpose Indoor Stadium has been constructed at a cost of Rs.8 crores.
- (3) Yoga Meditation Hall and Research Laboratory have been constructed at Cost of Rs. 8 crores
- (4) A Multi Gym for Men & Women has been constructed at a cost of Rs. 36 Lakhs.
- (5) A Camping Centre is being constructed at cost of Rs. 43 lakhs.
- (6) Basketball (2 courts), Volleyball (2 courts and fenced), Handball, Football, Hockey and Kabaddi grounds have been constructed.

It is important to note that our University has obtained Permanent affiliation from the Association of Indian Universities during 2016-17. Our University organized "SDAT State Inter University Football Men and Women Tournament", "AIU All India Inter University Korfball (Mixed) Tournament", "AIU South Zone Inter University Football (Women) Tournament", and "AIU All India Inter Zonal University Football (Women) Tournament", during the year 2016-17. An International Conference on "Sports Medicine, Physical Education, Sports Science and Yoga" was organized by this University on 18-19 January 2017, in which more than 300 participants from India and abroad and 100 Students were participated. More than 500 trees were planted in and around the University campus by the NSS Volunteers.

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Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed with the National and International Institutions during the Year 2016-17, such as "Vocational Education Training and Employment Australia Limited (VETEA), Australia, "Swamim Gujarat Sports University, India, and "with the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University for the Bio-Mechanic laboratory". One of the highest bodies of the University, the Planning Board has been constituted by the Chancellor with eight dignitaries as members of the Planning Board during the year 2016-17. The Chancellor also nominated three Professors and Heads of Departments of this University as Members of the Syndicate during December 2016.

RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

Totally 350 Ph.D. Scholars are on roll in the University Departments and 18 affiliated colleges. In fact, 63 Ph.D. and 73 M.Phil. degrees are to be awarded in this convocation and this is a testimony that is emphasized on research in our University.

The Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University, a unique and first of its kind in India, is situated in Melakottaiyur Village in a sprawling 125 acres of land. There are five Departments functioning here which offer Doctoral, Master and Bachelor levels of courses.

The Government has enhanced the Block Grant from Rs.1.87 crore to Rs.4.16 Crores towards the salary component. The second phase of work such as construction of 1st floor, staff quarters and laying of play fields etc., has reached completion stage.

As a new initiative the Tamil Nadu Government has sanctioned a sum of Rs.16.03 crores towards the construction of Multipurpose Indoor Stadium, International Standard Library, Conference Hall, Research Lab and Meditation Hall. I am glad to state that the Government has sanctioned Rs.2.00 crores for laying the link road, Rs.40 lakhs for construction of multigym for men and women, Rs. 35 lakhs for standardization of existing play fields, Rs.43 lakhs for establishing the Camping Centre, Rs.48 lakhs for establishing Sports Technology Lab, Rs.45 lakhs for the purchase of furniture and Rs.44 lakhs for the construction of Canteen. The university has entered MOU with SDAT for establishing Cycling Velodrome in our University Campus. These works are under progress. An anti-ragging monitoring cell has been established. So far no complaint has been received in this regard, which shows that the university and its affiliated colleges have proved to be ragging free institutions.

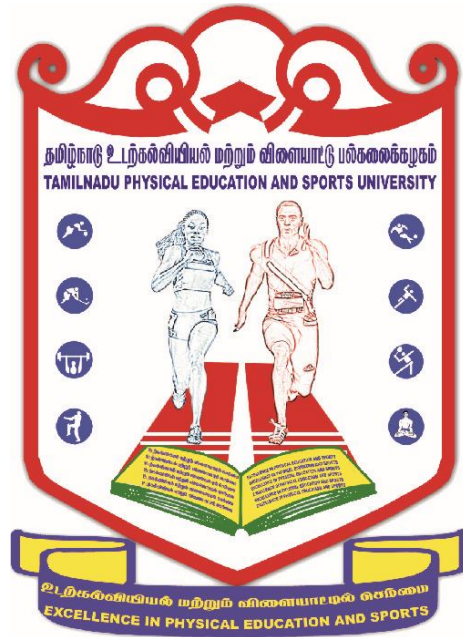

Our University which is functioning in the new Campus since 4th August 2011, spreads across 125 acres of land at Melakottaiyur located in between Vandalur and Kelambakkam, Chennai. Administrative Block, Academic Block, Hostels for Men and Women, Mess Halls, two warden's quarters, compound wall with proper roads inside the campus have been constructed at the cost of nine core and twenty five lakhs. In addition to this Rs. 1.38 crores has been sanctioned for the installation of 1000 KV High Tension Transformer. Now the Transformer has been erected and it is functioning since 15.11.2013.

62.5 K.V. generator has been purchased to get uninterrupted power supply for the day to day functioning of the University. Further to this our Government has sanctioned a sum of Rs.55/-lakhs towards erection of street light facilities inside the campus and it is necessary on my part to state that Rs. 27.50 lakhs have already been received by our University for this purpose and now the work is under progress.

The University has applied for one time Catch Up Grant for Rs.10 crores, Rs. 5 crores from University Grants Commission and another Rs.5 crores from State Government and I am glad to state that 1st installment has been sanctioned by the University Grants Commission and State Government and the same has now been utilized for the construction of First Floors over the existing building, layout of play fields, construction of staff quarters etc., These works are also under progress.

As a new initiative the Tamil Nadu Government has sanctioned a sum of Rs. 2.20 crores for establishing Sports Science Centre which will enhance the quality of research in all the areas of Physical Education and Allied Sciences. I am glad to state that the Government has sanctioned Rs. 36.88 lakhs under part II new scheme towards the construction of multimedia classroom and towards the purchase of innovative equipments. I am extremely happy to state that the Multimedia Classroom was inaugurated by Hon'ble Minister for Sports and Youth Welfare on 10.02.2014. And also I am glad to state that the Government has sanctioned Rs. 40/- lakhs towards the construction of Multi Gym for Men and Women and Rs. 35/- lakhs towards the standardization of existing Play fields.
