2. The Registrar has further stated as follows:

- (i) The First Vice-Chancellor has constituted three Ad-hoc Committees namely Ad-hoc-Committee-Administration, Ad-hoc-Committee-Finance and Ad-hoc-Committee-Academic by virtue of the powers vested on him under sub-section (5) of section of Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University Act 2004 to temporarily exercise and perform any of the powers and duties of such authority of said Act till such time an authority is duly constituted. The First Meeting of the Ad-hoc-Committee-Administration and the Ad-hoc-Committee-Finance held on 21.01.06 considered the various proposals including the proposal for the creation of posts of Officers and the Supporting Staffs, so as to enable the newly formed University to commence its official transaction instantly. The Second Meeting of the Ad-hoc-Committee-Finance and Administration held on 23.02.06 considered the various proposals including the Creation of Faculties, Departments, Teaching Staff in University Departments and the Post of Supporting Staff in the University center.
- (ii) The day-to-day official transactions of the University is being attended by the Vice-Chancellor, Registrar and the Consultant.
- (iii) The Ad-hoc-Committee-Finance and Ad-hoc-Committee-Administration in its meeting on 23.02.06 has approved the Creation of Four Faculties and departments thereon as indicated below on the recommendation of the Ad-hoc-Committee-Academic.
  - (1) Faculty of Teacher Education
    - a. Department of Physical Education
    - b. Department of Yoga
  - (2) Faculty of Sports and Youth Affairs
    - a. Department of Advanced Training and Coaching
    - b. Department of Youth Affairs and Adventure Sports (Supportive Department)
  - (3) Faculty of Allied Health Sciences
    - a. Department of Exercise Physiology and Nutrition
    - b. Department of Sports Psychology and Sociology
    - c. Department of Sports Biomechanics and Kinesiology
    - d. Department of Statistics and Computer Applications (Supportive Department)
    - e. Department of Sports Journalism and Communication (Supportive Department)

3. Management

- a. Department of Sports Management
- b. Department of Sports Technology

(iv) According to the guidelines of the UGC, each department of university should have adequate number of teaching staff in the cadre of Professor, Reader and Lecturer. For a full-fledged developed university, there will be a staffing pattern of Dean, Heads of Department, Professors, Readers and Lecturers with the compliment of atleast One Professor, Two Readers and Four Lecturers in each department. The university is being a new and distinct university, each department should have atleast One Professor, One Reader and Two Lecturers. In the main and vital department like the Department of Physical Education there should be One Professor, One Reader and Three Lecturers because the said department is the Basic Department of the University. In this distinct University there is an imperative need to have the Supportive Departments like - Department of Youth Affairs and Adventure Sports, Department of Statistics and Computer Application and the Department of Sports Journalism and Communication. The said Supportive Departments will render services purely of supportive nature for the functioning of the main departments effectively to excel in their field of offering programmes both in classroom and in the play field to suit the modern trend. Such Supportive Departments shall have initially atleast two Lecturers in each department for rendering their due service. Moreover this distinct University shall have also a compliment of supporting staff for the University centre.

(v) The Ad-hoc-committee Finance and Ad-hoc Committee Administration approved the creation of the 39 teaching staff in the Department of University and six supporting staff in the University Centre which will be functioning as a Health Centre of the University on the recommendation of the Ad-hoc-Committee Academic.

(vi) Only after the creation of the above mentioned Forty Five posts, the University shall commence its functioning by offering programmes in the Academic Year 2006-2007 effectively so as to ensure instant take off. In the entire functioning of the newly formed University is solely relying on the creation of the above-mentioned Forty Five posts.

3. The Government examined the request of the Registrar at para 2 above and decided to sanction 38 posts of Teaching Staff for eight university Departments and three supportive departments and five posts of supporting staff for University centre to Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University as detailed below:

In the letter read above the Registrar, Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University has stated that The Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University, Chennai was established by the Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University Act, 2004 and the said Act came into force with effect from 15<sup>th</sup> September 2005 by way of a notification issued in G.O.Ms.No.324, Higher Education Department, dt 15.9.2005.

2. The day-to-day official transaction of the University is being attended to by the Vice-Chancellor, Registrar and the Consultant. There are no other supporting staff. However, the services of two graduates with special qualification in computer application are utilized for attending on the Secretarial work and their remuneration component is being met from out of the fund allotted for contingency expenses. The first Meeting of the Ad-hoc Committee-Administration and the Ad-hoc Committee-Finance held on 21.1.2006 considered the proposal for the creation of two posts of Officers and 33 posts of Supporting Staffs and fill them up on deputation/ direct recruitment, so as to enable the newly formed University to commence its official transaction instantly. The post of Special Officer (Planning) may be created in principle and the said post shall be filled up when it is actually required with the full justification to be placed before the Finance Committee by then.

3. In view of the above position, the Registrar, Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University has requested orders for the creation of the following 35 posts with the annual recurring expenditure of Rs.31,34,400/- :-



3. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University has therefore requested to issue Government Orders towards sanctioning of two posts of Associate Professor and four posts of Assistant Professor for handling Physical Education courses.

In the 22<sup>nd</sup> Finance Committee meeting and 30<sup>th</sup> Syndicate meeting, it was resolved to create one post of Associate Professor and one post of Assistant Professor for M.P.Ed course. It was also resolved to create initially one post of Associate Professor and three posts of Assistant Professor for the proposed B.P.Ed course. Further, it was resolved that the remaining one post of Associate Professor and three posts of Assistant Professor shall be created after the commencement of B.P.Ed course.

2. In the Government Order 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Government had sanctioned one post of Associate Professor and one post of Assistant Professor for M.P.Ed course and one post of Associate Professor and three posts of Assistant Professor for B.P.Ed course to Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University.

2. In the letter dated 10.03.2017, the Registrar, Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University has stated that the remaining posts may be created for handling B.P.Ed course as approved in the 22<sup>nd</sup> Finance Committee meeting and 30<sup>th</sup> Syndicate meeting as per the New Regulations, 2014 of National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), as the new B.P.Ed course has already been started from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2016 onwards.

4. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University has therefore requested to issue Government orders towards sanctioning of one post of Associate Professor and three posts of Assistant Professor for handling the B.P.Ed programme in Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University.

5. The Government after careful examination sanction one post of Associate Professor in the scale of pay of Rs.37,400 - 67,000 + Grade Pay Rs.9,000/- and three posts of Assistant Professor in the scale of pay of Rs.15,600 -- 39,100+ Grade Pay Rs.6,000/- for handling the B.P.Ed programme in Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University subject to the following conditions:-

- i. One post of Associate Professor and three posts of Assistant Professor for B.P.Ed second year have to be filled up just prior to the start of second academic year 2017-18 by following proper selection procedure.
- ii. The student strength as per NCTE norms has to be maintained at its maximum.
- iii. The salary expenditure for the posts sanctioned in para 5(i) above has to be borne by Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University from its own resources.



**ORDER:**

In the letter first read above, the Registrar, Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University has stated that the School of Distance Education of Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University was started in the academic year 2007-2008. At present the university is offering a total number of 120 unique and innovative courses in under graduate and post graduate levels, PG diploma, diploma and certificate courses through distance mode. The university has 151 study centres across the country through which an approximate number of 2000 students have registered to pursue various courses every year.

2. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University has also stated that as per the University Grants Commission norms, approval of Distance Education Bureau (DEB) must be obtained for all the courses conducted through distance mode. In order to fulfill the norms of Distance Education Bureau, the Registrar, Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University has requested for the creation of three teaching posts and five non-teaching posts as minimum requirement.

3. The Government after careful examination, sanction three teaching posts and five non-teaching posts for School of Distance Education in Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University as detailed below:
